



The Willingboro Municipal Utilities Authority conducts its Fire Hydrant and Water Main Flushing Program in April & October. This flushing takes place during the day from 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

You may notice some discoloration of the water during this time. This is iron and manganese sediment which is being flushed from the mains. The water is safe and will clear up within a few hours.

As a practical matter, we do urge that you refrain from washing clothes or using the water unnecessarily while it is discolored.

The flushing of the water distribution system is required by regulations issued by the NJ Department of Environmental Protection.

This cleaning process removes any mineral sediment which routinely builds up in the water distribution system thereby insuring a safe and healthful water supply for our customers.

Another important benefit of hydrant and water main flushing is that every fire hydrant in the water distribution system is inspected for proper operation and needed repairs are made immediately by our System Maintenance Department.
