WHEREAS, the contract was awarded to MBE Mark III Electric, Inc., and

WHEREAS, the contractor as requested provided pricing for the following items:

- Replace deteriorated clearwell piping, lime tank overflow and install additional bollards,
   \$6,050.23
- Revise and replace existing deteriorated heat tracing to air stripper, well and high service pump, \$2,060.22
- 3. Furnish and install conduit and wire to HVAC dew point switch for activation of dehumidifier, \$4,360.08

WHEREAS the Consulting Engineer is recommending that the above items of work be performed and has reviewed the pricing submitted by the contractor and finds that it is reasonable and is therefore recommending approval of Contract Modification No. 5 in the amount of \$12,470.53, and
